



HOUSE AND ADMISSION RULES

- Visiting the KLM Open 2026 and/or participating in any of the activities is entirely at your own risk.
- It is not allowed to bring your own food and/or drink (with the exception of a refillable (water) bottle) to the KLM Open 2026.
- The organisation reserves the right to inspect bags and jackets. If you decide not to cooperate, you will not be granted an entry right to the KLM Open 2026.
- The occasion is impartial toward politics. Remarks that can be interpreted as politically inflammatory/offensive are forbidden and could be reported.
- Animals (with the exception of assistance dogs) are not allowed.
- The use or possession of (soft) drugs on the grounds is not allowed.
- Visitors under the age of 18 are prohibited from buying, accepting or consuming alcoholic beverages. The organisation reserves the right not to sell alcohol in case of misbehaviour or drunkenness.
- The organisation and its staff cannot be held responsible for the loss and/or theft of any property of visitors.
- It is forbidden to smoke on the event grounds except in the designated areas.
- It is not allowed to bring the following attributes onto the event grounds: professional film, photo or sound equipment (with the exception of accredited press), alcoholic drinks, hard drugs, soft drugs, glass, cans, plastic bottles, food, (fire) weapons, dangerous objects, selfie sticks or drones (both on the ground and in the air).
- Recording with professional equipment and/or professional sound equipment is not allowed without permission or issued accreditation from the organisation.
- Photographs, videos and sound recordings will be made during the KLM Open 2026. By entering the event site, you agree to participate in these recordings that may be used for professional and commercial purposes or safety monitoring.
- It is forbidden to distribute leaflets, flyers or other items at and around the KLM Open 2026. Also, no interviews may be conducted, surveys conducted, or commercial promotion made without permission from the organisation, even if for non-commercial purposes.
- You are obliged to follow instructions from the organisation and its staff in and around the premises the KLM Open 2026.
- Unwanted, annoying behaviour and/or discrimination will not be accepted. Based on behaviour, the organisation may deny access to the KLM Open 2026. Give each other the space to enjoy together.
- In situations where the house and entry rules do not speak sufficiently, the organisation will decide.
- Banners are not allowed on the KLM Open site.
- On-site searches of visitors may be conducted.
- Entering the venue means you automatically accept the DPWT integrity policy applying to ticket holders, which can be found on their website.
